Key topics covered in the Succession in Governance and Leadership Training were:

- 1 Understanding the difference between Governnace and Management
- 2 **Understanding financial management**
- 3 **Meeting Procedure**
- 4 **Enhancing skills in research and research methods**

A segment of the training included attending a tribal hui to observe how hui are run, what is discussed in the forum, how Hapū delegates feedback and gain an understanding of the important role of Hapū in the Te Waimana Kaaku Tribal and tribal development.

Irene Almond has this year taken on the role of Secretary of Tuapō Pā Komiti. "I took on the role because there was no-one else." She has quickly discovered that this mahi is more than taking minutes for your Pā/Hapū Komiti. She was quite clear that her knowledge of her tribal was "none". Her personal viewpoint was from a "sovereign" stance and during the initial stages she said "I fought within myself

about this. Now there is no confusion, everything is so

much clearer."



Through completing the training, she has a clearer understanding of what she terms 'the big picture' and its' importance, not just to the role itself but to gaining clarity about how the Pā & Hapū play an integral role within the Tribal and Te Waimana Whārua.

From the training, her understanding has grown, her confidence has been strengthened and her pathway ahead is clearer. "I now know what is expected of me and what I expect from others in key roles."

Through this new learning, Irene has grown an appreciation for how 'everything works' together and why. In summing up, "Things run smoother if we're all on the same page. This training [helps] bring that".
